AN ACT Relating to Fees for Tagging and Marking Beaver Skins.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2360, amended. The last sentence of the 6th paragraph of section 2360 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'A fee of ~~\$~~ 50c shall be paid by the trapper for each skin tagged and marked.'
