HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 227, L.D. 294, Resolve, Relating
to Fish Screen at Outlet of Rangeley Lake.

Amend said Resolve by striking out everything after
the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Fish screen at outlet of Rangeley Lake, Resolved:
That the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game be ordered
to return to the Rangeley Region Guide's and Sportsmen's
Association the fish trap or screen and parts thereof which
the department removed at the outlet of Rangeley Lake,
Franklin County; and be it further

Resolved: That the Rangeley Region Guide and Sports-
men Association be granted permission to install a fish
screen; and be it further

Resolved: That the Rangeley Region Guide and Sportsmen
Association be granted permission to stock Rangeley Lake
with Atlantic salmon.'
