**AN ACT Increasing Number of Members of Superintending School Committee
of Town of Fairfield.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1945, c. 47, § 2, amended. The first sentence of section 2 of chapter 47 of the private and special laws of 1945, is amended to read as follows :

‘The officers of the town who shall be nominated and elected by the qualified voters of the Town of Fairfield as hereinafter provided shall be: 5 councillors comprising a town council; § 5 members comprising the superintending school committee, and a town clerk.’

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1945, c. 47, § 2, amended. The last sentence of section 2 of chapter 47 of the private and special laws of 1945 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof :

‘The 3 members chosen in the manner provided for in this section shall designate by lot one member to serve 2 years and the other 2 members to serve 3 years. They shall certify such designation to the town clerk to be by him recorded. Thereafter the members shall be chosen at the annual meeting of the Town of Fairfield to hold office for 3 years. Said committee may fill vacancies occurring between annual meetings, and the term of office of any member of the committee so chosen shall expire at the next annual meeting.’
