AN ACT Increasing Allowance for Uniforms of the Police Department of the  
City of Lewiston.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 7-A, amended.** Section 7-A of Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as last amended by chapter 135 of the private and special laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 7-A. Uniforms for members.** The city shall supply members of the police department with necessary uniforms, but shall not expend more than ~~\$150~~ \$200 per member annually. The city shall supply male members of the police department who do not wear uniforms a clothing allowance not to exceed ~~\$150~~ \$200 annually. This section shall apply only to those who have been appointed permanent members of the police department for a least one year.'
