COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 238, L. D. 307, Bill, "An Act Relating to Trespass on Unimproved Land Devoted to Preservation of Wildlife."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"§3859. Trespass on land devoted to wildlife preservation
Whoever, other than a game warden or a humane agent, when
armed with any kind of firearm or with bow and arrow, willfully
and knowingly enters upon unimproved land devoted to the preser-
vation of wildlife and owned by a corporation organized under
Title 13, chapter 81, and having preservation of wildlife among
its purposes, and provided that all of the boundaries of said
land are posted with signs at least every 50 feet indicating
that said land is a wildlife preserve, shall be punished by a
fine of not more than \$50.' "
