**AN ACT Relating to Certain Financial Provisions of Charter of City of
Rockland.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1945, c. 125, Art. V, §§ 517-521, repealed. Sections 517 to 520 of article V of chapter 125 of the private and special laws of 1945 and section 521, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 96 of the private and special laws of 1951, are repealed.

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1945, c. 125, Art. VII, repealed. Article VII of chapter 125 of the private and special laws of 1945, as amended, is repealed.

Sec. 3. P. & S. L., 1945, c. 125, Art. VII-A, additional. Chapter 125 of the private and special laws of 1945 is amended by adding a new article VII-A to read as follows :

'ARTICLE VII-A

General Obligation Securities

728. General obligation securities. The municipal officers are authorized to borrow in anticipation of taxes and issue general obligation securities in the manner provided for under the general law.'
