HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 250,
L.D. 318, Bill, "An Act Relating to Penalty Relative
to Short Lobsters."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 5th,
6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th lines and inserting in place
thereof the following:

" 'A. And whoever does so shall be punished by a
fine of \$10 and in addition by a fine of \$5 for each such
lobster involved, up to and including the first 5, and by
a fine of \$25 for each such lobster in excess of 5, or by
imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both.'"
