COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 250, L.D. 318, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Penalty Relative to Short Lobsters."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last
4 lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

" 'A. And whoever does so shall be punished by a
fine of ~~\$10-and-in-addition-by-a-fine-of-\$5-for~~
~~each-such-lobster-involved,-or-by-imprisonment~~
~~for-not-more-than-90-days,-or-by-both~~ \$5 for
each lobster, up to and including 5, \$25 each
for all in excess of 5. ' "

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following:

"Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, §4455, sub-§1, A, amended.

Paragraph A of subsection 1 of section 4455 of Title 12 of the
Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'A. Whoever possesses any such tail section of
lobster meat shall be punished by a fine of ~~\$10~~
\$25 and in addition by a fine of \$5 for each such
tail section of lobster meat possessed, or by
imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both. ' "
