STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Penalty Relative to Short Lobsters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 4451, sub-§ 1, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection 1 of section 4451 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'A. And whoever does so shall be punished by a fine of 510 and in addition by a fine of 52 for each such lobster involved, or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both.'
