AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Members of Personnel Board.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 591, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 591 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The public members of the board shall receive ~~\$10~~ \$20 a day for the time actually spent in the discharge of their duties, and their necessary expenses.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Personnel Board the sum of \$565 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$750 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
