COMMITTEE OF CONFERENCE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 260, L. D. 330, Bill, "An Act Relating to Uniforms for Deputy Sheriffs."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting after the word "for" the word 'Full-Time'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the word 'uniforms" in the 4th line the underlined words 'for full-time deputies'

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the single quotation mark at the end the following underlined sentence:

'The number of uniforms to be furnished the sheriff and all full-time deputies in each county shall be as follows: Androscoggin,

11; Aroostook, 6; Cumberland, 18; Franklin, 4; Hancock, 5; Kennebec,

8; Knox, 6; Lincoln, 3; Oxford, 12; Penobscot, 12; Piscataquis, 3;

Sagadahoc, 3; Somerset, 4; Waldo, 5; Washington, 4 and York, 9.'
