AN ACT Limiting Number of Lobster Traps Per Person.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 4463-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4463-A to read as follows:

'Sec. 4463-A. Number of traps. It is unlawful for any person to set more than 250 lobster traps at any one time.'
