IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Creating Special Legislative Committee to Study Need for Bridge and Causeway to Chebeague Island, Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Committee. There is created a special legislative recess committee to consist of 2 Senators, appointed by the President of the Senate and 3 Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House. The committee shall designate the chairman.
- Sec. 2. Duties. The committee shall study the feasibility of and the recreational needs for a bridge and causeway to Chebeague Island, Cumberland County.
- Sec. 3. Meetings; expenses. Said committee shall meet within 30 days after the effective date of this Act and then at the call of the chairman. The members shall be paid necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
- Sec. 4. Report. The committee shall report the result of its study to the 103rd Legislature.
- Sec. 5. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. Any balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1967.
