STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Approval of School Building Plans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3623, amended. Section 3623 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the first sentence, 2 new sentences, as follows:

'Any secondary school plans for construction or additions to buildings designed to enroll fewer than 300 pupils shall be approved or disapproved by the board on the basis of the adequacy of the total educational program. Plans shall not be approved for a secondary school which employs fewer than 10 teachers, except in areas which are geographically isolated.
