## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Indemnification of Directors of Corporations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 13, § 146, repealed and replaced. Section 146 of Title 13 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 146. Right of indemnification. Each corporation shall have power to indemnify any director or officer or former director or officer of the corporation, or any person who may have served at its request as a director or officer of another corporation in which it owns shares of capital stock or of which it is a creditor, against expenses actually and reasonably incurred by him in connection with the defense of any action, suit or proceeding in which he is made a party by reason of being or having been such director or officer, except in relation to matters as to which he shall be adjudged in such action, suit or proceeding to be liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of duty to the corporation. Such indemnification shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which such director or officer may be entitled, under any bylaw, agreement, vote of shareholders or otherwise.'
