STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for a Legislative Conference Prior to the Convening of the roard Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Prelegislative conference. The Legislative Research Committee is authorized to plan for a prelegislative conference to be held prior to the convening of the 103rd Legislature in regular session to brief the incoming Legislators on the programs of the several state departments and the problems of State Government. Such conference shall be held in Augusta in lieu of Orono.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Legislative Research Committee the sum of \$15,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. Any balance shall not lapse until June 30, 1967.
