AN ACT Amending Charter of St. Mark's Home, Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1871, c. 560, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 560 of the private and special laws of 1871 is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Corporations; name; real and personal property; purpose. The rector, wardens and vestry of St. Mark's Church, Augusta, and their successors in office, are hereby constituted a body corporate and politic, by the name of St. Mark's Home for ~~Poor and Indigent~~ **Needy** Women, with authority to take and hold property, real and personal, for establishing and maintaining in said Augusta, a home for ~~poor and indigent~~ **needy** women, of the value of \$50,000 and to manage and control the same for the purpose aforesaid; and said corporation shall have all the powers and privileges and be subject to all the duties and liabilities of similar corporations in this State.'
