AN ACT Requiring Approval of Early Childhood Education Programs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 2502, additional. Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2502, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 2502. Approval of early childhood education programs. Childhood education programs enrolling children prior to grade 1 shall be approved by the commissioner. The State Board of Education shall establish standards for approval of these programs. The commissioner shall appoint an advisory committee of professional and lay persons to assist in the development of these standards.’
