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AN ACT Relating to Secondary Facilities in a School Administrative District.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 20, § 3456, sub-§ 2, amended.** Subsection 2 of section 3456 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'2. **Secondary facility.** ~~One secondary facility serving all of the pupils in grades 9 through 12 in the district. Whenever a district enrolls more than 700 pupils in grades 9 through 12, said district may operate more than one 4-year school.~~ Said ~~facility~~ facilities may be constituted as ~~a~~ 4-year ~~school~~ schools, or combined with grades 7 and 8 to form a 6-year school or 2 or more 3-year schools, except for children living remote from a public school as provided in section 912.'
