### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

### AN ACT Relating to Closed Time on Rabbits in Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2356, amended. The first paragraph of section 2356 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a closed season on wild hares or rabbits from the first day of March to the 30th day of the following September, except in the Counties of Aroostook, Franklin, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Oxford, Penobscot, Piscataquis, Somerset, Waldo and Washington, where there shall be a closed season from the first day of April to the 30th day of the following September.'
