RESOLVE, Relating to Stocking Rangeley Lake with Togue.

Rangeley Lake stocked with togue. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to plant a saturation stocking of togue, or lake trout, in Rangeley Lake for a period of one year.
