RESOLVE, Opening Certain Portion of Rangeley Stream to Fly Fishing.

Certain portion of Rangeley Stream opened to fly fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to reopen the so-called "Bathtub" on the Rangeley Stream to fly fishing only through September 15th, with a daily limit of one fish.
