STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Permitting Entrances from Liquor Premises to Owners' Living Quarters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 7, additional. Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 7 to read as follows:

'Sec. 7. Entrances from premises to living quarters. The commission (Liquor) may grant written permission to a licensed person, who operates a restaurant, tavern or retail store, to maintain an entrance, doorway or other aperture leading from the licensed premises to his living quarters.'
