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**RESOLVE, for Development of Park Facilities on Warren Island.**

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**Development of park facilities on Warren Island; appropriation. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$10,600 for the development of park facilities on Warren Island, in the Town of Islesboro, to be expended by and under the supervision of the State Park and Recreation Commission with approval of the Governor and Council.

Any balance on June 30, 1966 shall be carried forward to the 1966-67 fiscal year, but any unencumbered balance shall lapse on June 30, 1967.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This 76 acre island was a gift to the State by the Town of Islesboro in 1959, and offers excellent opportunities for picnicking and camping facilities to serve the rapidly increasing recreational boating on the coast. This request would provide a minimum of facilities to safely allow public use of the area.
