### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for Cottage Renovations at Boys Training Center.

Boys Training Center Renovation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Mental Health and Corrections the sum of \$218,000 for necessary renovation and remodeling of Farrington and Wentworth Cottages at the Boys Training Center; such work to be done under the direction of the Bureau of Public Improvements.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The renovation of existing Farrington and Wentworth cottages will provide housing for 35 boys each as well as adequate dining, toilet, shower and dayroom areas to allow the proper supervision of boys, and would further provide family living conditions for staff to supervise boys living in each respective cottage.

Both facilities are in disrepair and most inadequate to allow operation and supervision. Construction of a new cottage to house 24 boys requires approximately \$284,000.
