STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Hotel Harris, Rumford, for Additional Payment for Hotel Liquor License.

Hotel Harris; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$600 from funds of the Liquor Commission to be paid to the Hotel Harris in Rumford for additional payments made in 1963 and 1964 for a hotel liquor license, spirituous and vinous.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Since the population of Rumford by the last census is 10,015, Hotel Harris under the Revised Statutes, Title 28, section 701, paid \$300 additional in 1963 and 1964 for a hotel liquor license. It appears to be a hardship that an additional \$300 each year had to be paid because the population of Rumford was only 15 over 10,000.
