RESOLVE, Opening Cold Stream Pond, Penobscot County, to Ice Fishing.

Cold Stream Pond open to ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Cold Stream Pond in Enfield, Penobscot County to ice fishing during the month of February.
