SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 153, L. D. 394, Resolve, Proposing An  
Amendment to the Constitution to Lower the Voting Age to

Amend said Resolve in the Title by striking out the word  
"Eighteen" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Nineteen'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out in the 8th line  
the underlined word "eighteen" and inserting in place thereof the  
underlined word 'nineteen'

Further amend said Resolve, in the 13th line of the referendum,  
by striking out in the question the word "Eighteen" and inserting  
in place thereof the word 'Nineteen'
