AN ACT Relating to Eligibility of State Employees for Group Life Insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1151, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 1151 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, the State of Maine shall pay the premium for the first \$3,000 of the total amount of basic group life insurance to which each appointive officer or employee of the State of Maine is eligible, except that the State of Maine shall not pay the premium for any appointive officer or employee of the State of Maine who has signified his desire not to be insured, as provided in section 1151, subsection 4.'
