STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys to Supplement Loans by Maine School Building Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maine School Building Authority appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$25,000 to the Maine School Building Authority, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 for the purpose of providing grants to municipalities to supplement lease-rental agreements for construction of needed classroom facilities. This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1967.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In past years the State has provided a fund which the Maine School Building Authority has used to assist towns in hardship cases where resources were inadequate to provide minimum school facilities. No funds are now available for this purpose and some towns are too poor to provide needed classrooms.
