AN ACT Appropriating Moneys to Maine Maritime Academy for Construction of Warehouse and Garage.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Construction of Warehouse and Garage, Maine Maritime Academy. That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$146,600 to the Maine Maritime Academy to remove Noyes Building and to construct a warehouse and garage. Said sum shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Noyes Building, located on academy property, is a residence type building serving as an academy warehouse. It is in a state of disrepair to a point where reconstruction would be considered uneconomical and practically impossible. The academy is in need of a suitable warehouse for storage of property received at the academy. Additionally, there are no facilities for academy vehicle storage. The lower level of the warehouse would be suitable for a vehicle storage area. Attention to the existing building will be required in the immediate future.
