STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys to Maine Maritime Academy for Reconstruction of Dismukes Hall.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Reconstruction to Dismukes Hall, Maine Maritime Academy. That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$253,000 to the Maine Maritime Academy to reconstruct Dismukes Hall. Said sum shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Maine Maritime Academy is in need of additional, better equipped classrooms for students and additional office space for instructors. Reconstruction of vacated administrative spaces, sick bay, and auditorium will provide these required spaces. The building is badly in need of interior reconstruction to include better classrooms, an adequate physics laboratory and better student classrooms. Improved heating, lighting, and equipment are urgently needed.
