**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Vocational Educational Institute in  
Northern Kennebec County.**

**Vocational Educational Institute; appropriation for. Resolved:** That the Department of Education is authorized and directed to establish, maintain and operate a State Vocational Educational Institute in such location in Northern Kennebec County as it deems best, to promote specialized training for those who give evidence of special aptitude or need and who desire specialized training designed specifically to train for service in trade, industry or commerce; and be it further

**Resolved:** That the Department of Education is authorized and empowered to receive such gifts and donations, either from public or private sources as may be offered unconditionally; and be it further

**Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$800,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 to carry out the purposes of this resolve. The breakdown shall be as follows:
