RESOLVE, to Reimburse Town of Hanover for Aid Extended Floyd Merrill.

Town of Hanover; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$300 to be paid to the Town of Hanover to reimburse the town for support of Floyd Merrill.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Floyd Merrill, having lost his settlement in the Town of Hanover in May 1963, fell in distress in the City of Bath on November 2, 1963; was provided relief in the amount of \$300.00.

After a full investigation, Hanover overseers of the poor are certain this Floyd Merrill has lost his Hanover settlement and now is the State's responsibility to provide Mr. Merrill with relief when needed.

The Town of Hanover is without legal recourse to recover from the State of Maine the said money expended in behalf of Floyd Merrill.
