STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse George S. Graffam of Whitefield for Loss by Spraying Neighboring Blueberry Fields.

Reimbursement; George S. Graffam. Resolved: That there is appropriated to George S. Graffam, of Whitefield, from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,200 for loss of bees, a cow and hay by the use of pesticides used on specifications recommended by the State of Maine to spray neighboring blueberry fields.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Pesticides were used to spray blueberry fields near Mr. Graffam's property in amounts and content recommended by the State of Maine. Loss to his property resulted.
