RESOLVE, Relating to Transfer of Profits from Institutional Farms.

Transfer of profits from institutional farms. Resolved: That current or accrued profits from any institutional farm under the control of the Department of Mental Health and Corrections, upon recommendation of the commissioner of said department, may be made available by the Governor and Council for the operation of the institution at which such farm is located, and in the event that the operation of an institutional farm shall be discontinued, the Governor and Council, upon recommendation of said commissioner, may make available any of the accrued profits from the operation of such farm for the operation of, or for the improvement of the program of, the institution at which such farm is located, or may transfer any of such profits to any of the other institutional farms.
