**RESOLVE to Reconstruct Route No. 5 Between Cornish and Limerick,
York County.**

Reconstruction of Route No. 5. Resolved. That the Highway Commission be directed to reconstruct Route No. 5 between the Towns of Cornish and Limerick, York County; and be it further

Resolved: That there be allocated from the General Highway Fund sufficient moneys to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

Statement of Facts

This highway is a heavily traveled one and the condition of the highway is intolerable.
