HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 335, L.D. 438, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Taking Smelts at Damariscotta Mills, Lincoln County."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause,
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do
not become effective until 90 days after the adjournment of the
Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, smelt fishing is an important industry and con-
servation methods are vital to protect and foster the industry;
and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to
become effective for the late winter and early spring months in
1965; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, the
following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
