#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Employment of Minors Under 18 Years of Age.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 772, amended. Section 772 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 772. Minors under 18. No minor under 18 years of age shall be employed in, about or in connection with any manufacturing or mechanical establishment, laundry, dry cleaning establishment or bakery in any capacity that the commissioner determines to be hazardous, dangerous to their lives or limbs, injurious to morals or where their health will be injured. This section shall not apply to minors in public and approved private schools wherein mechanical equipment is installed and operated primarily for purposes of instruction.'
