COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 342, L.D. 445, Bill, "An  
Act Relating to Employment of Minors Under 16 Years  
of Age."

Amend said Bill, in the 5th line, by striking out the  
underlined words and punctuation "construction activity,  
woods operation."

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the last  
sentence the following new sentence:

'No minor under 16 years of age shall be permitted to work as  
the operator of power equipment in construction activity or  
woods operations.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end before  
the single quotation mark the following new sentence:

'This section shall not apply to any such child who is employed  
directly by, with or under the supervision of either or both  
of its parents or legal guardian.'
