COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 347, L.D. 449, Bill, "An Act Relating to Compensation of Aldermen of City of Lewiston."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"'Sec. 9. Compensation. The members of the board of aldermen shall recieve as full compensation for the performance of their official duties as aldermen the sum of \$20 for each meeting of the city council which they shall attend provided that no aldermen shall be paid an amount in excess of \$700 \$1,000 for such attendance during any one fiscal year.

Members-of-the-board-of-aldermen-when-they-shall-convene-for the-purpose-of-constituting-a-board-of-examiners-in-insanity cases-shall-receive-as-full-compensation-for-such-duties-the sum-of-\$10-for-each-meeting-attended.'"
