STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Aldermen of City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. V, § 9, amended. Section 9 of Article V of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 141 of the private and special laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 9. Compensation. The members of the board of aldermen shall receive as full compensation for the performance of their official duties as aldermen the sum of \$20 for each meeting of the city council which they shall attend provided that no aldermen shall be paid an amount in excess of \$700 \$1,000 for such attendance during any one fiscal year. Members of the board of aldermen when they shall convene for the purpose of constituting a board of examiners in insanity cases shall receive as full compensation for such duties the sum of \$10 for each meeting attended.'
