AN ACT Relating to an Electrical Inspector for City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XVI, § 23, additional. Article XVI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is amended by adding a new section 23 to read as follows:

'Sec. 23. Electrical inspector. The Board of Electrical Examiners shall have authority to employ an electrical inspector, set his compensation, subject to the approval of the board of finance and prescribe his duties. Said appointment shall be for a period of 3 years unless removed for cause prior to the termination of his appointment. The Board of Electrical Examiners shall prescribe such rules and regulations as necessary for the safe installation, repair and maintenance of all electrical installations or other related matters and the electrical inspector shall enforce said rules and regulations. He shall attend meetings of the board and make monthly inspection reports with disposal of said inspections. The electrical inspector must be a state licensed master electrician.'
