STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Interest in Contracts by City of Portland Officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1961, c. 194, Art. VIII, § 1, amended. The first sentence of section 1 of article VIII of chapter 194 of the private and special laws of 1961 is amended to read as follows:

'No city manager, no member of the city council, no subordinate city officer, no member of any board or commission charged with the expenditure of any money appropriated by the city council or belonging to the city, no officer or employee of the city, elected or appointed, shall be interested, directly or indirectly, in any contract entered into by or in behalf of the City of Portland for work or material, or the purchase thereof, to be furnished to or performed for the city, and all contracts made in violation hereof are void and the city treasurer is expressly forbidden to pay any money out of the city treasury on account of any such contract.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1961, c. 194, Art. VIII, § 1, amended. Section 1 of article VIII of chapter 194 of the private and special laws of 1961 is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

'This section shall not apply to purchases of the city by competitive bidding.'
