STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Chairman and Membership of Board of Finance of City of
Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. VIII, § 1, repealed and replaced. Section 1 of article VIII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 1. **Members of board of finance.** The board of finance shall consist of 4 members to be appointed by the mayor for a term of 4 years. No successor will be appointed by the mayor of the finance board member whose term expires in 1965.’

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. VIII, § 3, repealed and replaced. Section 3 of article VIII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 3. **Chairman.** The mayor shall be ex officio the chairman of the board of finance and the authority of said mayor to act and vote shall be coextensive with the 4 other members of said board of finance.’
