## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Initial Type Registration Plates for Trucks and Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. I. R. S., T. 29, § 192, amended. The first sentence of section 192 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The Secretary of State is authorized to design and to issue, under such regulations as he shall deem appropriate, initial type registration plates or combination of initials and numeric type registration plates to be used on passenger motor vehicles, **trucks**, **trailers** or motor vehicles of the station wagon type in lieu of other numeric type registration plates.'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 192, amended. The first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 192 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Applications for registration plates as prescribed above, pertaining to owners of passenger vehicles, **trucks**, **trailers** or motor vehicles of the station wagon type who are residents of this State and who own an unrevoked and unexpired official amateur radio station license issued by the Federal Communications Commission, except those licensed as novices, by the Federal Communications Commission, shall be accompanied by a notarized proof of ownership of such amateur radio station license.'
