IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Repealing Law Regulating Business on Sundays and Certain Holidays.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 3204, repealed. Section 3204 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.
