AN ACT to Remove Floating Islands in Toddy Pond in Surry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Forest Commissioner to dispose of "floating islands." The Forest Commissioner is authorized and directed to dispose of the "floating islands", so-called, in Toddy Pond in the County of Hancock in a manner to alleviate the menace to life, health and property in the surrounding territory.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated the sum of \$5,000 from the Un-appropriated Surplus of the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act. Any unexpended balances shall lapse to the General Fund.
