AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Aid in Dredging the Royal River and Basin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriating funds to aid in dredging of the Royal River and Basin.

There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Town of Yarmouth the sum of \$44,000 to aid said town to dredge a channel 80' x 8' in the Royal River and Basin of 8 acres. Such appropriation shall not be available until the sum of \$44,000 has been appropriated by the Town of Yarmouth for the same purpose and the sum of \$200,000 shall have been made available by the United States under section 107 of the 1960 River and Harbor Act for the same purpose. Such appropriation shall not lapse until June 30, 1967.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A navigation project for the improvement of Royal River and Basin in the Town of Yarmouth has been approved by the U. S. Army Engineer Division, New England, for accomplishment under authority of section 107 of the 1960 River and Harbor Act. The project provides for an 8-acre anchorage, channel 80' by 8'.

This project is estimated to cost \$288,000 of which a cash contribution of 48% for the first cost of construction of the 8-acre anchorage is to be made.
