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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Harry B. Philbrick of Augusta.**

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**Harry B. Philbrick; compensated. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,113.28 to be paid to Harry B. Philbrick of Augusta for damages to and expenses in connection with the occupancy of his property in the Town of Belgrade by an ADC mother and her children.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Philbrick's dwelling in the Town of Belgrade was occupied by an ADC mother and her children rent free from November 1, 1963 to March 1, 1964 when the premises were abandoned without notice or arrangements being made for heating the property. The purpose of this resolve is to compensate Mr. Philbrick for damages to the property because of frozen plumbing, losses sustained from the destruction and removal of apparel and furnishing and expenses incurred by the family for fuel, electricity and other items.
